Overview

With the continuing evolution of the role of the pharmacist in patient care, more and more pharmacists are being told/ asked to "start a clinical practice". What exactly does this mean? Many pharmacists do not have the confidence to go out and start a clinical practice, and this is not something that is taught in pharmacy school.

Through this program of lectures and discussions the participants should gain an understanding of the following:

- 1) how to get a practice started;
- 2) establishing your role on the patient care team;
- 3) making clinical interventions and recommendations regarding a patient's drug therapy;
- 4) systematic approaches to monitoring a patient's drug therapy; and
- 5) documentation of clinical activities.

About the speaker

Dr. Grant Sklar, Pharm.D., BCPS is a Senior Lecturer, Department of Pharmacy, NUS, and a Clinical Pharmacist, Department of Pharmacy, NUH. Dr. Sklar received his education and training in Canada and the United States, and is board certified as a Pharmacotherapy Specialist. He has extensive experience as a clinical pharmacist in adult internal medicine and drug information. Dr. Sklar currently maintains an active clinical practice in adult internal medicine at NUH. In his various positions, Dr. Sklar has had the experience of developing a clinical practice where none existed before. He also has experience in mentoring future clinicians through precepting over 60 students (BSc, Pharm.D., and MPharm), interns and residents during the course of his career.
